


Pillars of Wisdom

An unusual formation of thick white water columns, all at fixed and different heights. Highest is 2m. Not a conventional water feature, but eye-catching because it is different. Will work well with classical statuary positioned in the pool possibly on pillars.

LaminarJet™

Absolutely not a standard jet of water. In fact you may not believe these glass like rods are water. A patent design produces a solid arc of water with no splashing so you can walk under it. When lit at night, the rod becomes an arc of colour. LaminarJet™ fountains are best installed indoors, away from wind and air currents, and need specific installation conditions which we shall be happy to advise.

Rainbow Tunnel

Four LaminarJet[™] arches in a row making a tunnel effect that can bridge an aisle or walkway. Each arch is lit in a different colour. Includes two enclosures to house LaminarJet[™] and pump. Open top of the enclosure has mesh cover suitable for placing pebbles, stones, artificial grass etc.





Mirage

Excellent as the centre piece indoors in a building lobby, mall or hotel. Four LaminarJet™ arch up and over and are caught in a central vessel. Each arch is lit in a different colour. Four enclosures for LaminarJet™ and a central vessel.

Arch of Joy

A feature for an entrance way, a unique welcome. Two LaminarJet™ close together for a prominent arch effect. Lit with a choice of one or two colours. Includes two enclosures.





Circle of Concord

One of the meanings of concord is peace and watching this fountain will certainly bring peace of mind and relaxation. Two rings with solid arch like features made up of multiple jets. The arches on each ring rise and fall slowly together. Those on one ring are rising whilst on the other ring they are falling. At the centre is a ring of mist, this does not move and anchors the design.

Bursting Jet

In the BurstingJet™ a jet rises with a ball of water at the top, the stream then cuts off and the head falls back with a splash. This is a continuous process occurring approximately sixty times a minute. The operation is entirely automatic and requires no moving parts, outside control or connection. The constant motion catches the eye and we offer a range of fountains to display this beautiful and interesting effect.

BurstingJet[™] fountains require comparatively low horsepower whilst still providing a prominent display.

Jumping Around Column

An interesting combination. A 'solid' columnar jet at the centre and six BurstingJet $^{\text{TM}}$ 'play' around it.





Bursting with Joy

No less than seven BurstingJet[™] to entertain. A tall central one surrounded by six shorter jets - always in motion.

Ring of Fun

The central BurstingJet™ 'plays' within an inside drop ring. Has the beauty of a ring fountain with the constant interest of the BurstingJet™.





Bursting In-Line

Here is a solution to filling a long narrow or a rectangular shaped pool with a lot of continuous interest - six BurstingJet $^{\text{TM}}$ in a line.

Single BurstingJet™

A solitary but elegant display to catch the eye and provide the happy sound of falling water.





Contemplation

A fountain that will assist contemplation as one moves into a relaxed state of mind. Two rings with solid arch-like features made up of multiple jets. The arches on each ring rise and fall slowly together. Those on one ring are rising whilst on the other ring they are falling.

Balancing Rock

A large rock seems to be supported on a thick column of water. People do not believe their eyes and it certainly seems to be at odds with the forces of nature and liable to come crashing down at any moment. This is however not going to happen as the rock is a lightweight but extremely realistic molding which is supported on a pole completely hidden by the water column.





Grand Sequencing

The Grand Sequencing is a dynamic fountain and so named because the water patterns constantly change under programmed control. Change is not abrupt but progressive - one effect slowly comes up as another goes down. At any one time, several groups of effects may be up along with changing coloured lighting. Literally scores of combinations of effects and colours are possible, so it is a very entertaining and intriguing fountain. And using large effects ensures the fountain is prominent and regal.

This is a large dynamic sequencing fountain. These are not catalogued but are custom designed to specific requirements and sites thus making each unique and exclusive.





Floating Fountains

If you have a fresh water body, a fountain will not only beautify it but it will help keep the water fresh and healthy through oxygenation. In fact there are models specifically recommended to do this as efficiently as possible by moving the maximum water per kw and with the highest oxygen transfer. There is a wide range and all feature floats or floatation systems made of extremely durable fiberglass reinforced plastic (FRP) with polyurethane foam filling which prevents water ingress and sinking even if float is damaged.

Compact Style

Shown is Cascade from a range of models, all of which are neat and compact and suitable for smaller fresh water bodies. The complete package includes fountain, pump, lighting, cables and electrical control panel.

Boat Style

What is more appropriate to be floating on water than a boat. And from the boat graceful or spectacular water jets play to add beauty and interest to any fresh water body. The classical white boat conceals almost everything - pump, lighting and nozzles. We supply complete packages with anchoring, submersible cables and electrical control cabinet.





Logo Fountain

Variable Height Nozzles are spaced to make alphabet letters or a similar design. Best viewed with the effect at eye level or higher and against a dark back ground - a black marble/granite wall for example. This is unique signage for a company name, institution, hotel or logo. Custom design made to your requirement.

Tubular Motion

A dynamic fountain with the outside and inside rings sliding slowly up and down in opposite directions, whilst maintaining the angular cut-off tubular formation. This is not only an intriguing shape, sure to get attention, but utterly relaxing and contemporary. When not operating in dynamic mode the fountain can be stopped - frozen in whatever position pleases. Lighting is with economical LED lights giving brilliant, rich constantly changing colours.





Spiral Fountain

This is a static fountain made possible with our new Variable Height Nozzle (patent pending). All the jets look the same and have the same thickness but are adjusted for varying heights so that the spiral shape can be easily made out which would not be possible if all jets were the same height. LED lights produce dense, deep and rich colours slowly blending from colour to colour.

Our designers were inspired by the brief appearance of a fountain of this concept in the 1998 Robert De Niro thriller Ronin and had to develop the VHN to achieve it properly. Now it's not just unique to a South of France hotel, but all can enjoy!

Dome of Delight

A dome of mist approximately 2.5m in diameter with LED lighting for exceptional pure and bright colours. The lights diffuse through the water so that the entire dome is lit in solid colour. Colours slowly change and blend through the spectrum. Very attractive and relaxing. This fountain will be viewed best if it is in an elevated pool 1.5 to 2m high.
